Shelter Now Transitional Support Program, is a recovery oriented program, designed to support clients with obtaining permanent housing and connections to supports

1. No illegal activity of any kind is permitted in the units or on the grounds of Shelter Now.
2. All clients are expected to maintain a respectful environment for staff, residents and guests of the building.
3. Each client is expected to uphold the dignity and respect the privacy and rights of the other clients.
4. Threatening or violent behaviour toward Staff or other occupants may result in immediate discharge from the program.
5. All clients are expected to accept case management supports and be actively working on goals.
6. Guest Policy- No visitors are permitted in the unit between 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 am, overnight guests are not permitted.
7. All clients are expected to contribute to cleaning of the building as well as maintaining and caring for the grounds and community garden.
8. Clients are expected to regularly clean and maintain their unit.
9. Only the client or the client's family can live in the unit. To live in the unit you must be on the Occupancy Agreement
10. Prescriptions must be taken in accordance to your prescription from the Doctor. No sharing, trading, or selling of medications is permitted.
11. All units are furnished by Shelter Now, personal furnishings are not permitted in the unit
12. Housing fees are geared to income and are to be paid on the first day of the month.
13. Smoking is not permitted in the units; there are designated smoking areas throughout the property.
14. Pets are not permitted in the units.

Security-Shelter Now is monitored by video cameras; these cameras are in all the common areas including the outdoor property.
